The Department of Behavioral and Social Sciences at the University of Montevallo in Alabama invites applications for the position of Assistant Professor of the Social Work beginning Fall 2012. This tenure-track position will be filled at a rank commensurate by an applicant with experience teaching in a BSW program. Social work is one of six programs in an interdisciplinary department committed to the liberal arts and collegial cooperation. The successful candidate will demonstrate a commitment to liberal arts education and working with other department/university programs.

SPECIFIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: Responsibilities include teaching undergraduate courses such as social work practice courses, research, social policy, and HBSE; community service; committee work; research and scholarly activities; and BSW recruitment and advisement. The candidate is also expected to have experience and knowledge of CSWE Standards.

MINIMUM EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE: Applicants must have a Ph.D. degree with teaching experience, and a CSWE-accredited MSW with two years full-time post-MSW experience.

PREFERRED EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE: Expertise in teaching social work at the BSW-level with the following courses: social work practice at micro and macro-levels, research, social policy, and HBSE.
