Job Title: Group Facilitator

Employer/Agency: Baylor College of Medicine Community Programs

Job Description:

Our program has a number of grant funded programs that provide youth leadership and mentoring to at-risk youth and youth on probation. This position would involve facilitation of youth leadership groups, providing mentoring, training interns, and program evaluation. In addition, this position has a lead role in the Pasadena community, identifying programming options, networking in the community, and ensuring the completion of all grant requirements. Bilingual (Spanish-speaking) – preferred.

Responsibilities include:

1. Assist in coordination and final development of all group session curriculum components and activities consistent with the Too Good for Drugs & Violence curriculum, and integrate Search Institute asset development curricula and activities into after school recreational programming for On BELAY.
2. Assist in participant recruitment, validation of criteria/screening procedures.
3. Implementation of On BELAY participant recruitment procedures – communication with participating schools and all curriculum components and community-based events – with particular emphasis on meeting linguistic needs of parents and youth.
4. Assist in implementation of the community events and facilitation of weekly On BELAY group sessions and community-based youth projects.
5. Oversees curriculum development/translation needs of program to assure parent and youth access to materials in language most conducive to learning.
6. Assist Program Coordinator in completion of all required Pre- and Post-tests in compliance with the Too good for Violence curriculum activities and Search Institute asset development materials.
7. Participation in weekly supervision with Program Director, assist in coordination and support of MSW Trainees.
8. Interface with other JP Service providers to cultivate leadership project opportunities for youth.
9. Assist Program Coordinator in maintenance of ongoing communication with the JP Program and submission of required reports, as indicated by the contract.
10. Marketing of the On BELAY Program/Community outreach to families and organizations to enhance participation opportunities for youth and families in all aspects of the program and ensure success of the youth-generated parent involvement activities.
11. Collaboration with existing community resources to meet identified needs and share resources/training and youth developed materials with other programs.

12. Translate materials into Spanish, as needed for youth and family participants, as well as facilitation of groups/mentoring in Spanish, as needed. Assurance of culturally sensitive programming.

Qualifications: Bachelor's or Master's in Social Work. Preferred - two years of relevant work experience. Prefer – Spanish speaking.

Salary/Hours: Full time. Salary based on experience.
