Job Title: Healing Species Group Facilitator

Job Description:

Our program has a number of grant funded programs that provide youth leadership and mentoring to at-risk youth and youth on probation. This part time position (maximum 8 hours per week) would involve facilitation of the Healing Species curriculum to youth in residential facilities. This curriculum teaches youth empathy while incorporating companion rescue dogs. Travel to Katy and Seabrook may be required. Bilingual (Spanish-speaking) – preferred.

Responsibilities include:

1. Assist in coordination and final development of all group session curriculum components and activities consistent with the Healing Species curriculum.
2. Interface with other JP Service providers to cultivate project opportunities for youth and to ensure smooth implementation of the program.
3. Assist Program Coordinator in maintenance of ongoing communication with the JP Program and submission of required reports, as indicated by the contract.

Qualifications: Bachelor's or Master's in Social Work. Preferred - two years of relevant work experience. Prefer – Spanish speaking.

Salary/Hours: Maximum 8 hours per week to provide 11-week curriculum, plus training. Paid one time stipend, based on experience.
