**Assistant Professor**

The Rhode Island College School of Social Work invites nominations and applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position in its MSW program, beginning fall semester 2012. The individual will participate in curriculum development and teaching of courses in research, policy practice, and macro practice courses. Expertise in a substantive area such as gerontology, child welfare or macro practice is essential.

The successful candidate will have an MSW degree from a CSWE-accredited institution and a doctorate in social work or related field, at least two years of post-MSW social work experience, and teaching experience or evidence of effective teaching skills. Candidates with strong interest in pursuing research/program evaluation in the community are preferred. Persons from underrepresented groups are especially encouraged to apply.

The School of Social Work is proud of its 30 year history of educating MSW and BSW social workers throughout Rhode Island and Southeastern New England. The MSW and BSW programs currently serve 250 students. The school has a stable and established faculty committed to social justice and working with oppressed populations.
