



The School of Social Work at St. Ambrose University invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant or Associate Professor in Social Work, beginning July 1, 2012. Responsibilities include ability to teach across the Social Work curriculum, an intended scholarship agenda, university committee service, and student advising. This MSW-only program has a single concentration in Empowerment Social Work Practice. The position requires an MSW from a CSWE-accredited program and doctorate in social work or related field, although applications from ABD's will be considered. A minimum of two years post-MSW experience is required and evidence of effective teaching is essential. Salary will be commensurate with rank and experience. Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled. Women and persons of diverse cultural and ethnic background are especially encouraged to apply. Priority will be given to applicants showing a strong commitment to teaching and scholarly engagement. St. Ambrose is a Catholic, Diocesan University located in Davenport, Iowa, which is a midsized urban area on the Mississippi River, enrolling over 3700 students.
