Assistant Clinical Professor is a nine-month, non-tenure track position; responsibilities include teaching four (4) undergraduate social work courses per semester face to face and web-based, student mentoring and service activities and an expressed willingness or experience to work in a diverse university community. The position is a one academic year contract with opportunity for renewal beyond 2012-2013, contingent upon effective performance, the continued availability of funds and program needs.

The Northern Arizona University Social Work Program offers the BSW degree and is accredited by the Council on Social Work Education (completed a successful reaffirmation in June 2011 under the new EPAS). The BSW Program is available through two campus locations: Flagstaff Mountain Campus and Yuma Campus. Northern Arizona University is a 25,000-student institution with its main campus in Flagstaff. NAU Yuma Branch Campus is a designated Hispanic Serving Institution located on the Arizona, California, and Mexico border.
