

Tenure track, nine month program coordinator/faculty position in Social Work

Virginia Intermont College, a private, liberal arts-based institution, seeks a dynamic teacher to hold the position of Assistant Professor of Social Work and program coordinator. Responsibilities include teaching undergraduate social work courses (Introduction to Social Work, Human Behavior/Social Environments, Social Work Practice, History of Social Welfare, Human Diversity & Ethnic Issues, Social Programs and Policy Issues), advising students, recruiting students into the program, ensuring on-going social work accreditation through the Council on Social Work Education (CSWE), and providing service to the College's governance by serving on college committees. Minimum qualifications: M.S.W. in Social Work and two years post graduate practice experience in the social work profession and two years college teaching experience; prefer Ph.D. in Social Work. Candidates should be able to teach day and evening courses, show primary interest in teaching and mentoring undergraduate students, exhibit knowledge of or willingness to learn CSWE core competency requirements, and demonstrate active scholarly interests in issues of diversity and social justice.

Located in Bristol, Virginia Intermont is a private, liberal arts-based institution in southwest Virginia with an enrollment of approximately 600, the coeducational college offers four bachelor degrees, along with two associate degrees. The equine studies and photography and digital imaging programs are nationally recognized for excellence.
