**Position:** Faculty member in Social Work, rank open, tenure track

**Starting date:** August 2012

**Responsibilities:**

- The normal teaching load is 12 credits per semester.
- The successful candidate will possess the qualifications necessary to assume primary responsibilities for micro and mezzo level social work practice methods and social work research classes. Depending on experience and candidate strengths, the position may include administrative responsibilities for the program.

**Qualifications:**

- A completed Ph.D. or DSW and teaching experience is strongly preferred; candidates who have matriculated into a Ph.D. program will be considered. All candidates must have at least two years post- masters (M.S.W. /MSSA) professional experience and possess Ohio LISW licensure or be qualified and willing to sit for the Ohio LISW exam.
- Sincere commitment to the Christian Faith and a commitment to the integration of faith and learning in the academic discipline.
- Preference will be given to those with college-level teaching experience and a commitment to scholarly research.

**Department of Social Work**

The Department of Social Work prepares students for entry-level generalist social work practices in diverse settings. It consists of three full time faculty with varying research interests. The program enrolls approximately 50 majors and is accredited by CSWE.

**Malone University**
