

## **BSW Program Director**

The Department of Social Work at the University of Minnesota, Duluth seeks to fill a full-time, tenure track faculty position at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor for its accredited MSW program and also to serve as BSW Program Director for the newly developed BSW Program. Job duties and responsibilities include overseeing the BSW program, teaching, advising, research, and service. This position is 25% BSW Program Director and 75% teaching/research/service. Required qualifications include a Doctorate in Social Work or closely related field from a regionally accredited university program; A Master's Degree in Social Work (MSW) from a program accredited by the Council on Social Work Education; Two years Social Work practice experience; Evidence of effective written communication skills; Evidence of effective teaching in higher education; A clearly articulated research agenda and demonstration of ability to carry it out; Prior experience demonstrating administrative skills in areas such as program development, recruitment and retention of students, program planning and implementation; Expertise in one or more of the following areas of practice: human behavior in the social environment, social policy, research, community practice, child welfare, social work with diverse populations, field and global issues; and Valid Minnesota social work license or verification of eligibility for licensure by the Minnesota Board of Social Work. Complete applications will be reviewed beginning December 2, 2013 until filled.
