Job Description	The Mission of the UHD BSW Program is to prepare entry-level social workers for theoretically informed, value-based, justice-oriented, generalist practice in an urban environment and to prepare students for future professional development and graduate study. To help achieve this mission, the BSW Field Practicum Director will have full responsibility for managing all aspects of the student Field Practicum experience including, but not limited to, student assessment, placement, process and outcomes evaluation, and grading. Specifically, Field Practicum Director duties include recruitment and development of appropriate, high-quality practicum sites and supervisors; continuous oversight and evaluation of all students, agencies, and field supervisors to meet CSWE educational and practice standards; field stipend development and management; and BSW Program recruitment. The Field Practicum Director will teach 2 courses each long semester and two courses during the summer. This position is a 12-month, non-tenure track Teaching Faculty appointment that will report directly to the BSW Program Director.
