The School of Social Work is a unit of the Robert Stempel College of Public Health and Social Work (RSCPHSW) at Florida International University in Miami, Florida. The School has 400 students in the BSSW and MSW Programs and 20 students in the Ph.D. Program in Social Welfare. The faculty has been ranked fourth in scholarly productivity among social work/social welfare doctoral faculties in a recent Academic Analytics survey. The School is seeking two colleagues who can teach in the School's degree programs and contribute to social work's knowledge base by carrying out original research and disseminating the results in publications. The School invites applications to fill two (2) tenure-track Assistant Professor positions in the School of Social Work.

Responsibilities will include, but are not limited to, teaching human behavior in the social environment (position 1) and teaching direct social work practice (position 2) as well as other courses assigned by the Director, advise students, conduct research, and provide service to the school, college, university and community.

Applicants must have at a minimum: A Ph.D. in Social Work or closely related field and demonstrated potential to make a substantial contribution to the profession's knowledge base. In addition, for the direct practice position, the applicant must have earned an MSW from a school of social work accredited by CSWE and have two years of social work practice experience. For the human behavior position, an MSW and practice experience is strongly preferred. Applicants should submit a CV and the names of three persons who are willing to serve as references.

Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience.
