Minimum Qualifications: Completed MSW; New Jersey Social Work licensure eligible. BSW and/or MSW teaching experience preferred. 4 years post MSW social work experience or 1 year post MSW social work experience with 2 years pre MSW social justice or human rights related experience. Demonstrated evidence of maintaining professional currency; excellent communicator; collegial work style and commitment to the interests of the School and the profession. The successful candidate will have a demonstrated commitment to diversity, social justice and human rights.

Duties: Teaching foundation courses (Human Behavior, Field, Human Rights and Social Justice) in the BSW and MSW (foundation and advanced) curriculum, advising students, collaborating on school issues and extensive committee work, including any work related to CSWE accreditation.

The University: Monmouth is a private non sectarian university located in West Long Branch, New Jersey. The University is located less than one mile from the Atlantic Ocean, and one and one half hours from either New York City or Philadelphia. The student body is diverse. Although most students come from New Jersey, 19 States and 35 nations are represented.

The School of Social Work has maintained an accredited BSW Program since 1975 and an MSW Program (accredited 2000) with concentrations in Clinical Practice with Families and Children and International and Community Development.
