### **Position: ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF SOCIAL WORK, TENURE-TRACK POSITION**

Nine-month position, not necessarily the academic year

**Classification and Salary:** Assistant Professor - Commensurate with experience; competitive salary in accordance with IFO collective bargaining agreement

**Date of Appointment:** August 21, 2012

#### **Qualifications and Experience:**

Required - \* MSW degree from a CSWE-accredited social work program; \* Doctorate in social work or related field (ABD status will be considered); \* Completed doctorate in social work or related field required for tenure; \* 3 years of post-MSW social work practice experience with 2 years experience in child welfare services; \* Demonstrated effective teaching experience at the post-secondary level; \* Demonstrated ability to work successfully with students of diverse backgrounds, including sensitivity to their needs and concerns. \* Demonstrated ability to incorporate content related to multiculturalism, anti-oppression, and social justice change.

Preferred - \* Demonstrated ability to manage grants; \* Scholarly or creative achievement commensurate with experience.

#### **Responsibilities:**

Primary teaching responsibilities: \* A willingness to teach core courses across the generalist social work practice curriculum; \* Incorporation of content related to multiculturalism, oppression, and social justice change; \* Specific emphasis: child welfare services.

Other responsibilities include: \* Student advising; \* Contributions to student growth and development; \* Scholarly or creative achievement or research; \* Continuing professional development; \* Service to university and community; \* Managing the departmental child welfare grant.

Preferred: \* Demonstrated effective teaching experience at the post-secondary level; \* Demonstrated ability to work successfully with students of diverse backgrounds, including sensitivity to their needs and concerns; \* Experience teaching research methods/policy analysis; \* Demonstrated ability in technical/professional writing.
