IDD Service Coordinator II – Full Time

Requires Bachelors Degree from an accredited college or university with a major in social, behavioral or human services. Two years experience in working with individuals with IDD and/or a related condition, and effective communication skills. Duties include completing assessments to identify needs; develops an individual plan of care which documents the delivery of appropriate services and supports based on the individual's choices and preferred outcomes; links, refers and coordinates the services offered through Tri-County Services and community resources; monitors progress monthly to ensure quality and appropriateness of services; provides advocacy and crisis prevention/management as needed, documents services. Applicants must have a valid TDL and be insurable through Tri-County.

C & A Licensed Clinician – Part Time

Requires Masters Degree in Behavioral Science Field, one year mental health experience, licensed as a LPC, LCSW or LMFT in the State of Texas. This is a part-time position, providing individual and family therapy as well as case management to children, adolescents, and their families who meet criteria for services. Services are provided in the office and in community settings. This position will also provide back-up for other C&A LPHA's with the following responsibilities: Conduct intake assessments, provide LPHA diagnostic reviews for C&A, review C&A Treatment Plans, and provide therapy services at Lone Star Clinic. Must be able to meet DSHS Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) Competency Standards within 1 year from hire date. Applicants must have a TDL and be insurable through Tri-County.

Advance Nurse Practitioner

Requires the completion of an accredited education program and certification by the National Commission on Certification of Physician Assistants or graduation from an accredited education program with a Master's degree in nursing and a current license as a Nurse Practitioner. Applicant has to be eligible for prescriptive authority and eligible for certification as a Psychiatric Nurse Specialist. This position performs moderately complex psychiatric duties in an outpatient setting within the scope of practice of the NCCPA, or a Licensed Nurse Practitioner. Duties involve the prescribing of psychiatric medications under the supervision of a licensed psychiatrist, as well as assessing medical and psychological histories, completing psychiatric diagnosis for determining priority population status and participating in treatment planning. This position will provide crisis intervention services to new and existing consumers. Applicants must have a valid TDL and be insurable through Tri-County.
