Job Description:	<p>The Silver School of Social Work at New York University invites applications for an Assistant Dean for Field Learning and Community Partnerships, beginning as soon as the successful candidate is identified.</p> <p>The Assistant Dean is responsible for leading an efficient and effective student learning-centered field education curriculum in accordance with CSWE and Silver School of Social Work curriculum standards. The Assistant Dean will work to advance the School's strategic plan. The Assistant Dean is the leader of the Office of Field Learning and Community Partnerships and oversees the work of its educational, administrative, and community agency components.</p> <p>The successful candidate will work with faculty and the Associate Dean to develop policies related to field learning. Innovation is an important part of the position; the Assistant Dean will participate in the development of new initiatives such as dual degree and off-site programs and new models of field education and advisement. In addition, the candidate will manage the Field Learning and Community Partnerships budget and attract resources to support field education innovation. The Assistant Dean is responsible for field placement operations that are strong in student services and that support the School's enrollment services objectives.</p>
Qualifications:	<p>The successful candidate must have an MSW degree. Experience in social work education as a faculty member or a field educator particularly in the tri-state area is required. A PhD in social work or a related field is preferred. The successful Assistant Dean candidate will have a strong leadership record and a track record of leading innovations and organizational change and renewal. Leadership in a complex organizational environment and knowledge of educational and administrative technology tools is also required. The position is a non-tenure track faculty position. The appointment is open rank and will be made at the level suitable to the candidate's qualifications and experience.
