

## Assistant Lecturer, Academic Professional, Position Number 2555:

Applications are requested for an academic professional at the assistant lecturer level for the University of Wyoming/Casper campus (UW/C). This position serves as BSW Coordinator and is physically located in Casper. The anticipated start date for this position is no later than August 1, 2014. Social workers with experience teaching in higher education and in field instruction are encouraged to apply.

The University of Wyoming in Laramie is the state's only provider of baccalaureate and graduate education. UW combines major university benefits and small school advantages. The Casper community, located approximately 2 ½ hours from Laramie, is the second largest in the state and offers a wide range of outdoor activities and cultural experiences while maintaining a community atmosphere. The Division of Social Work offers a baccalaureate program at the UW/C. This program has the capacity of serving 50 students and has been offered at UW/C for more than 30 years.

**Required qualifications:** Applicant must have an MSW degree from a CSWE-accredited institution and two years post-MSW practice experience. Applicants must have experience teaching in a higher education environment.

**Preferred qualifications:** Preference will be given to applicants with administrative experience.
