Campbellsville University is hiring an Assistant/Associate Professor in the Carver School of Social Work & Counseling to fill a position created by student growth and a developing MSW program. The BSW and MSW programs are accredited by CSWE. Campbellsville University is a coeducational, Baptist affiliated university with a current student enrollment slightly over 3,200 students.

**Job Description:** Selected candidate is responsible for course instruction, advising students, serving as a field liaison if necessary, scholarly activity commensurate with the mission of the University, and/or maintaining service relationships with community agencies/organizations, applied research, and engaging in university and community service. A commitment to diversity and student success is essential. This position reports to the Dean in the Carver School of Social Work and Counseling.

**Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:** Demonstrated record of excellence as an educator/scholar/practitioner in an accredited MSW/BSW program; the ability to teach in two or more of the following Social Work content areas: direct practice in social work, human behavior, policy, evidence based research; and experience in using technologies as an instructional method in the classroom. Experience and commitment in the use of technology in distance learning or a willingness to learn and deliver this mode of instruction is a must. Instructional activities will primarily occur at the Campbellsville University, Campbellsville Kentucky location; however, an occasional course will be required at the Louisville or Somerset extended center locations. The qualified applicant will have an appreciation for faith based service and practice scholarship.

**Minimum Qualifications:** Earned Doctorate in Social Work or Marriage and Family Therapy and a Master of Social Work degree from a CSWE accredited program. Candidate must have a minimum of 2 years of post MSW practice experience in a practice setting. ABD will be considered if degree is scheduled for confirmation within one year of hire date.

**Preferred Qualifications:** A minimum of 2 years college/university level teaching experience in a regionally accredited MSW, BSW or MFT program. Ideal candidates should have the ability to teach across the curriculum, but especially practice, diversity, social policy, and organization.
