Presidential Search Request for Nominations and Applications

Academic Search wants to bring to your attention an exceptional leadership opportunity. **SUNY Buffalo State** seeks a visionary, collaborative and strategic scholar with significant administrative experience to assume the position of **president** no later than August 1, 2014. In order to invite finalists to campus for interviews prior to commencement in early May, we invite applications and nominations to be sent to us as soon as possible. With a total enrollment of 10,665 in fall 2013 (9,338 undergraduates and 1,327 graduates), Buffalo State has the largest enrollment of SUNY's comprehensive colleges. SUNY Buffalo State offers more than 170 undergraduate programs with 11 honors options, 18 post-baccalaureate teacher certification programs, and more than 65 opportunities for graduate study. While Buffalo State's exceptional faculty – which features 48 members who have been awarded the SUNY Chancellor's Award for Excellence in Teaching, and seven who have been honored as SUNY Distinguished Teaching Professors – is consistently recognized nationally and internationally for its research, the commitment of faculty members to classroom teaching is a hallmark of the campus. With nearly 90 percent of its classes averaging less than 40 students, Buffalo State is the perfect blend of small college learning environments coupled with large university opportunities.

The college is located in the vibrant, historic region of Buffalo Niagara, New York State's second-largest metropolitan area. More than one million people enjoy the many advantages of city life, including professional sports and an impressive number of cultural and recreational activities. The accessible 125-acre campus is located in Buffalo's cultural corridor. Buffalo State is home to the critically acclaimed Burchfield Penney Art Center and adjacent to the world-class Albright-Knox Art Gallery and Olmsted-designed Delaware Park. The campus is close to trendy cafes, restaurants, shops, a beautiful waterfront development, and Victorian-styled housing. The culturally rich and diverse city of Buffalo, home to more than 250,000 residents, is undergoing an economic resurgence and has been recently cited as one of America's most livable cities. The President's House, a historic, elegant home on a tree-lined street, is within walking distance of the campus core.

Review of candidates will begin immediately and continue until a new president is appointed. To be assured full consideration, applications should be received by **March 28, 2014**.

Applications should include (1) a cover letter that describes how the applicant's experiences match the required qualifications and an understanding of the challenges and opportunities described in the Presidential Prospectus; (2) a résumé or curriculum vitae; and (3) a list of five references. Nominations and expressions of interest will be treated in confidence; references will not be contacted without prior approval of the candidate.
