<b>Job Description</b>	<p>The CST Survivor Advocate will serve as an intensive support system for child victims of sex trafficking. Working within a continuum of care model, the survivor advocate's responsibilities will include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) responding to call out locations within 90 minutes to assist minor victims with emotional support and basic needs;</li> <li>2) to provide intensive emotional support during first 72 hours;</li> <li>3) to follow minimum contact protocol with youth survivor throughout the service plan;</li> <li>4) participate in the Rapid Response Team meetings for emergency placement and follow-up service planning;</li> <li>5) participate in monthly Multi-Disciplinary Team meetings for long-term planning for youth;</li> <li>6) maintain supportive contact with survivor and parent/guardian (as appropriate) throughout the service delivery period;</li> <li>7) provide information and referrals for additional services;</li> <li>8) accompany survivors to meetings and/or appointments;</li> <li>9) maintain accurate documentation in case files and enter case data into a web-based data management system;</li> <li>10) participate in weekly supervision meetings with program coordinator; and</li> <li>11) attend relevant training and conferences to advance knowledge and skills set.</li> </ol>
