The School of Social Work invites applications for an MSW Program Director with a proposed starting date of August 16, 2012. This is a full time, non-tenured faculty appointment at the rank of Clinical Associate Professor with a 50% release for administrative duties. Candidates must have an established record of scholarship, teaching, and administrative experience.

### **Responsibilities:**

Curriculum oversight and administration for the MSW Program and MSW Outreach Program  
Chairs the MSW Program Committee and supports the concentration committees  
Ensures compliance with CSWE accreditation standards for the MSW Program  
Coordinates with the Associate Dean regarding curriculum, assessment, and scheduling classes  
Coordinates with Assistant Deans regarding recruitment, admissions, student services and field education

### **Qualifications:**

Master's degree in social work from a CSWE-accredited program is required; preferably a Ph.D. in social work. Candidates must be familiar with CSWE accreditation standards. Preference will be given to candidates with prior experience in administering either a BSW or MSW program or who have prior experience with CSWE accreditation, such as serving as a site visitor. Experience with online and distance education is highly preferred.
