Assistant Professor of Social Work

Defiance College invites applications and nominations for a full-time tenure-track assistant professor of Social Work.

The Social Work program has been continuously CSWE accredited since 1976 and boasts a 95.5% licensure pass rate. The program is a leader in Defiance College's nationally-recognized service learning and community-based learning initiatives.

Responsibilities include a 4/4 teaching load that focuses on a variety of Social Work courses including direct and group practice and policy. Program responsibilities require advising the student organization and participating in program events. The position also includes academic advising; curriculum development; committee work; and service to the college.

The successful candidate must have an MSW plus two years post-Master's experience in the Social Work field. For the rank of Assistant Professor, the candidate must have at least three years of college teaching experience. For candidates with less college teaching experience, the rank would be Instructor. Preference will be given to candidates with a doctorate (DSW or PhD) and with interests and experience in international social work and/or autism spectrum disorders.

Defiance College, chartered in 1850, is an independent, coeducational, liberal arts institution affiliated with the United Church of Christ. The campus is located on 150 acres in a residential area in the city of Defiance in Northwest Ohio and has a student population of just over 1,000.
