- Identify and screen individuals whom have been referred for case management
 - Provide case management to children and pregnant women with special needs
 - Must be able to travel between locations as needed
 - Assess each client's medical and psychosocial history and current service needs

 - Document service provided in client record within 24 hours
 - Attend required training and ongoing education offered by the agency
 - Participates in the Performance Improvement Program
 - Perform all other duties and tasks as assigned
- Qualifications:**
- Bilingual (English/Spanish) is preferred. If the employee is bilingual then they must have written and verbal fluency in English and Spanish
 - Be a social worker (with Bachelor's or advanced degree) or a Registered Nurse (with a diploma, an Associate's, Bachelor's or advanced degree)
 - Must be currently licensed by their respective Texas licensure board and whose license is not

- All Case Managers must maintain their professional licenses as defined by the respective Texas licensing/examining boards.
 - Case Managers must comply with all applicable recognitions/designations, such as the Independent Practice Recognition as defined by Texas licensing/examining board.
