The ideal candidate will provide current social work clinical practice knowledge and skills to further enrich the capacity of the GSSWSR to provide clinical practice education to social work students. It is expected that the candidate will be engaged in a full array of faculty roles and responsibilities consistent with employment as an interim faculty member at Bryn Mawr College.</p> <p><i>Teaching:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be capable of teaching the required master’s level clinical practice courses: (a) Clinical Social Work I & II, as well as (b) Assessment and Psychopathology. • Must be able to teach and/or develop new content for at least two other clinical electives from within the course offerings of the GSSWSR clinical track including: Addictions; Clinical Social Work with Children and Adolescents; Family Therapy; Couples Therapy; Clinical Practice with Aging and/or Stress & Trauma. • Teach a maximum of 6 courses within an academic year. <p><i>Curricular Planning and Management:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participate in the ongoing work of the Full-time Faculty (tenured and tenure-track faculty) Teaching Group(s) associated with courses being taught. • Participate with Full-time Faculty and the Faculty Curriculum Committee in the development and review of course syllabi for advanced electives. <p><i>Student Advising:</i> Serve as a student advisor for a cohort of enrolled MSS students</p> <p><i>Other Faculty Roles:</i> Participate in faculty meetings and assist in the work of the GSSWSR faculty, faculty committees and work groups, as requested by the Faculty Convener and the Dean.</p>
Qualifications	<p>Candidates must possess an MSS/MSW degree and have extensive (5+ years) post-Master’s practice experience. While not required, the ideal candidate for this position will hold a PhD in Social Work or a DSW degree. Additionally, prior teaching experience, ideally 5+ years, in social work education is preferred. Candidates must have the skills required to teach the clinical advanced practice sequence, as well as the foundation course in Assessment and Psychopathology. Successful applicants will have the knowledge and experience to support teaching clinical electives in areas such as stress and trauma, addictions, child and adolescent social work and/or family therapy. Prior experience in supervising and/or advising graduate social work students is helpful.</p>
