Job Description	<p>This position is intended to augment the full-time tenured and tenure-track foundation curriculum faculty. The ideal candidate will provide current and broad-based social work direct practice and community practice knowledge and skills to further enrich the capacity of the GSSWSR to provide its foundation curriculum and advanced practice electives to social work students. It is expected that the candidate will be engaged in a full array of faculty roles and responsibilities consistent with employment as an interim faculty member at Bryn Mawr College.</p> <p><i>Teaching:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Must be capable of teaching the required foundation curriculum courses: (a) Foundation Practice I and II, (b) Theoretical Perspectives (Human Behavior in the Social Environment) I and/or II, (c) Community Assessment and (d) Multiculturalism and Diversity.</i> • <i>Must be able to teach two other advanced practice electives including, but not limited to Group Treatment, and Social Work Practice in Health and Mental Health Systems.</i> • <i>The interim faculty member will be expected to teach a maximum of 6 courses within an academic calendar year.</i> <p><i>Curriculum Planning and Management:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Participate in the ongoing work of the Full-time Faculty (tenured and tenure-track faculty) Teaching Group(s) associated with courses being taught.</i> • <i>Participate with Full-time Faculty, and the Faculty Curriculum Committee, in the development and review of course syllabi for the advanced electives.</i> <p><i>Student Advising: Serve as a student advisor for a cohort of enrolled MSS students</i> <i>Other Faculty Roles: Participate in faculty meetings and assist in the work of the GSSWSR faculty, faculty committees and work groups, as requested by the Faculty Convener and the Dean.</i></p>
Qualifications	<p>Candidates must possess an MSS/MSW degree and have extensive (5+ years) post-Masters broad-based practice experience in direct practice particularly at the community and policy levels of practice. While not required, the ideal candidate will possess a PhD in social work or a DSW degree. Additionally, prior teaching experience, ideally 5+ years, in social work education is preferred. Candidates must have the skills required to teach Foundation Practice, as well as the foundation courses in Community Assessment and Multiculturalism and Diversity. Successful applicants will have the knowledge and experience to support teaching advanced practice electives in areas such as group treatment and social work practice in health and mental health systems. Prior experience in supervising and/or advising graduate social work students is helpful, as candidates may be asked to take on an advising role in the MSS program.</p>
