The University of Tennessee at Martin seeks applications for Dean of the College of Education, Health, and Behavioral Sciences. The University of Tennessee at Martin is a primary campus in the University of Tennessee System and is located in Northwest Tennessee approximately 125 miles north of Memphis and 150 miles west of Nashville. The University of Tennessee at Martin has a combined graduate and undergraduate enrollment of approximately 8,000 students. The emphasis is solidly on excellence in teaching, applied research, and service. The University is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

Description: The Dean of the College of Education, Health, and Behavioral Sciences is the chief academic officer of the College reporting to the Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs. There are approximately 77 faculty members in the College of Education, Health, and Behavioral Sciences within the four academic departments: Behavioral Sciences (Sociology, Psychology, Social Work, & Criminal Justice); Educational Studies; Health and Human Performance; and Nursing. The College of Education, Health, and Behavioral Sciences also houses the Office of Interdisciplinary Studies.

The successful candidate must possess the following qualifications: 1) a terminal degree/earned doctorate in a discipline within the College or appropriate to the position; 2) academic record of effective leadership as a dean, assistant dean, chair or equivalent administrative position with direct supervision of faculty and staff, 3) significant experience in planning, budgeting, assessment and interdisciplinary program development, and success in obtaining grant funding; 4) demonstrated knowledge of and ability to work collaboratively as a supportive member of an academic team; 5) knowledge of accreditation processes in the College which include NCATE, ACEN, and CSWE; 6) academic credentials sufficient to qualify for the rank of Associate or Professor; and 7) vision and interpersonal skills needed to work collegially with diverse faculty, staff, students, alumni, school partners, and professionals across disciplines.

Candidates should provide electronic submissions including a letter of interest, full vita, one page statement of administrative philosophy, and contact information (name, address, phone and e-mail) of five professional references. Review of applications will begin July 1, 2014 and continue until the position is filled. Position is available January 1, 2015.
