

The TCU Department of Social Work invites applications for a full-time, nine-month lecturer position beginning August 2014. The Department, offering BSW and MSW degrees, is located in the Harris College of Nursing and Health Sciences.

The person in this position will be assigned primarily to teach in the MSW program. Applicants must demonstrate a strong commitment to quality teaching and be willing to teach in both undergraduate and graduate programs. The MSW program offers the Advanced Generalist concentration with specializations in areas of children and families or health and mental health. Expected teaching areas may include Professional Foundation/Intro, Advanced Practice, Policy Analysis, HBSE, and elective courses.
