The UH GCSW Field Education Office, along with the Director of Online Education, have created a new professional Field Coordinator position (see brief description below) and is currently accepting applications. This is a full-time position, and is different than the Field Liaison role.

This position will work closely with the Director of Field Education and the Director of Online Education to create, implement, support and maintain all aspects of field education for the online and hybrid MSW students. The position will be responsible for the identification, development and maintenance of agency placements to serve this population of students. This position will serve as the primary student contact and support for all field related matters for this cohort of students. The position will require extensive use of technology, some travel and evening/weekend hours.

Preferred minimum qualifications: Master of Social Work degree with a minimum of two years social work experience, post MSW.

Experience as a field instructor for MSW students.

Experience, as a student or instructor, with online/virtual education.

Knowledge of CSWE (Council on Social Work Education) requirements.

Knowledge of the social service system in Houston and Texas.

Established record working with community agencies.

Professional license in good standing (LMSW, LCSW).
