



**Eastern Michigan University, School of Social Work**  
Position Announcement

Eastern Michigan University (EMU) seeks applicants for a tenure track, Assistant Professor position to begin in Fall 2012, in the School of Social Work. The School offers a BSW and an MSW with concentrations in Children and Family Services, Mental Illness/Chemical Dependency, and Services to the Aging. The School has **24** faculty members, and a student body of approximately **200** MSW and **600** BSW students.

The School's mission encompasses a commitment to the empowerment of poor, oppressed, vulnerable, and underserved populations; the creation of social welfare policy based on a strengths perspective; the advancement of community problem solving; and leadership in organizations and communities.

Successful candidates will advance this mission by contributing to a curriculum promoting social justice and empowerment-oriented practice. Applicants must have an MSW and five years professional social work experience (at least two years following completion of the MSW). The ideal candidate will teach generalist practice courses and **content relating to mental illness and chemical dependency**. Familiarity with evidence-based practices is expected. Prior teaching at both the BSW and MSW level and a capacity to teach research is desirable. A PhD is strongly preferred, although ABD candidates nearing completion will be considered.

Other qualifications include the demonstrated capacity to contribute to the University and the community through service activities; the evidence of potential to engage in scholarly publication; and a demonstrated commitment to the social work profession.
