Job Title: Assistant or Associate Professor

Job Description: The Department of Social Work at The University of North Carolina at Greensboro (UNCG) invites applications and nominations for two, nine-month, tenure-track positions; one at the Assistant level and one at the Assistant or Associate level. Both positions are available Fall 2013. Now is an especially exciting time for the department as we enter our fortieth year of partnership with the Department of Sociology and Social Work at North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University (NCA&TSU); an historically black university (HBCU). Specifically, the Joint Master of Social Work Program is a collaboration with NCA&TSU, and the BSW Program has a forty-year-old joint field instruction program with NCA&TSU. The Department has 275 BSW majors, 90 MSW students, and 13 full-time faculty. The Department, School of Health and Human Sciences, and University place a high value on teaching and community-engaged scholarship.

Qualifications: A strong commitment to diversity/inclusion, social justice, and student-centered social work education is **essential** for these positions. We are particularly looking for **scholars who also love teaching**, who are actively involved in research and publication, and have a track record in securing external funding for appointment at the Associate Professor level or potential for securing external funding for appointment at the Assistant Professor level. The persons in these positions will have teaching responsibilities across both the BSW and the MSW programs. We especially seek **teaching experience** in social policy; practice with individuals, groups, communities, and organizations. Teachers and scholars who study **aging and diversity** are strongly encouraged to apply, as are those with clinical practice experience. Applicants must possess an MSW and a Ph.D. in social work or a related field and have at least 2 years post-master's experience.

Additionally, **the successful candidate** must:
Work effectively within a diverse department and promote a collegial work environment; Be an active citizen in the school and university, with partnering universities and the broader community; Have successful or demonstrated potential for successful social work teaching; Have excellent

interpersonal and teamwork skills and enjoy interdepartmental and interdisciplinary collaboration; Have a record of scholarship appropriate for appointment at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor; and Strengthen graduate and undergraduate programs, and support student needs.
