**Job Title:** Assistant Professor

**Job Description:** Assistant professor will teach courses in macro-level social work practice (communities and organizations), community research, social welfare policy, and introduction to social work. The candidate may assume duties as director of the Community Research Center and Telephone Survey Center, and secure external funding through these centers.

**Qualifications:** Skills in grant-writing, evaluation research, and community needs assessment are essential. Candidates must hold a Master's degree in social work from a CSWE-accredited program, have at least two years of post-MSW degree practice experience, and hold a doctorate in social work or sociology (or be ABD with an expected degree completion date of August 2014). The Department is seeking a person with a strong commitment to, and demonstrated excellence in, undergraduate teaching. Special consideration will be given to candidates who have experience with racially and ethnically diverse groups, including Native Americans, Hmong and other Southeast Asians, Latinos, and African Americans. Salary is commensurate with experience. Teaching assignments will typically be 12 credits per semester. Responsibilities also include scholarship and university service.

Master's degree in social work from a CSWE-accredited program, have at least two years of post-MSW degree practice experience, and hold a doctorate in social work or sociology. ABD will be considered but PhD must be in hand by August 2014 for consideration for retention.
