BSW Tenure-Track Faculty Position Announcement

Southern Connecticut State University in New Haven, Connecticut, invites applications for a full time, tenure track position. The position is in the Department of Social Work and begins in August 2014. The successful candidate will be responsible for teaching undergraduate and/or graduate students in the areas of social welfare policy and macro practice, with the opportunity to teach across the curricula.

About the University: Southern Connecticut State University is located in New Haven, a culturally vibrant environment surrounded by many fine Universities with easy access to New York City and Boston.

About the Social Work Program:

The mission of the Department of Social Work is to provide quality social work education to undergraduate and graduate students and to advance knowledge through study, practice, and research. The purpose of undergraduate education is to prepare students to work in BSW level agency-based social work positions and to enter graduate social work programs. The purpose of graduate education is to prepare students for direct clinical practice at generalist and advanced levels.

The teaching load at SCSU is 12 credits per semester. Additional faculty responsibilities include student advising and committee assignments. Candidates must also demonstrate the capacity to produce peer-reviewed scholarship. Faculty Reassigned Time may be available for research and scholarship endeavors.

Required Qualifications: Applicants must possess an MSW and a PhD or (DSW) in Social Work or related field from an accredited college or university. ABD's will be considered based on evidence of completion of doctorate. Two years teaching at either an undergraduate or graduate level program in social work desirable. Successful record in obtaining grants is also desirable.
