We are seeking an ASSISTANT or ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR with expertise in clinical social work practice and research with an emphasis on behavioral and mental health/health disparities in high risk, high need populations. A candidate with experience or a desire to gain experience in international social work practice is preferred.

Position Summary: We are particularly interested in candidates of diverse backgrounds with clinical practice experience and intervention research focusing on special populations such as military families and/or minority youth and families. We are particularly interested in individuals whose areas of research and practice are in behavioral & mental health change through trauma-informed care with individuals and families across contexts. Other experience that is of interest is in substance abuse (CADC), forensic/court-involved social work, and person-centered care and interdisciplinary collaboration.

About the School: The Graduate School of Social Work at Dominican University prepares professional social workers for globally focused, family-centered practice with diverse, oppressed, at-risk populations through rigorous education, practice, research and service. Dominican University offers the first MSW program in Illinois to specialize in this globally oriented curriculum. We have concentrations in globally focused, family-centered and military social work with additional certifications in school social work and gerontology. We have dual degrees with Business and the Library Information Science schools. We are a private teaching institution with an accredited CSWE MSW program whose mission is centered on truth, compassion, empowerment and social justice.

Qualifications: Applicants should possess a doctorate (or be nearing completion of dissertation) in social work or a related social science field. They should have a commitment to research, service, and teaching. Preferred qualifications include an MSW with practice experience with diverse populations and communities both within the United States and internationally, clinical license, team-based, online and/or blended teaching at the BSW or MSW levels, the ability to speak a second language, and potential for grant writing, and scholarship in social work. Candidates applying for the Associate Professor level must have an established record of scholarship and teaching, and must meet the University's requirements for the rank.

Position Expectations: The successful candidate is expected to provide leadership in the school's clinical practice curriculum, including clinical research and practice evaluation, initiate and publish research, teach three graduate level courses per semester, advise and mentor MSW students, provide leadership in relevant focus areas of the MSW curriculum, and serve on school and University committees. The candidate is also expected to support and be involved in the school's international initiatives where they intersect with her/his areas of expertise.
