Long Island University, Brooklyn Campus invites applicants for a full time, tenure track Assistant Professor in the Department of Social Work commencing fall 2012. The successful candidate will have the opportunity to teach across the curriculum in both our graduate and undergraduate programs. Expertise in teaching research is desired.

Our 5 year old MSW program, through collaboration with other departments, has concentrations in the following areas: Child and Family Welfare, Substance Abuse, Gerontology, Not-for-Profit Management and Forensics. The MSW program is mostly an evening and weekend MSW program with approximately 170 MSW students. The department also has a 13 year old CSWE-accredited undergraduate social work program (BASW) with approximately 80 declared majors. Although our MSW program is jointly accredited through CSWE with the University's CW Post Campus, the advertised faculty position is located on the Brooklyn Campus. The candidate is expected to successfully be able to work with individuals of diverse ethnic, cultural and religious backgrounds.

Requirements include a MSW with two years postgraduate experience and a PhD/DSW in social work or a related field. Demonstrated teaching excellence at the college level and ability to conduct research and publish are also required. Competitive salary commensurate with qualifications and experience.

About the University: LIU is a private university established in 1926. The Brooklyn campus offers over 195 academic programs serving approximately 8600 students. It is one of the fastest growing and most ethnically diverse campuses in the metropolitan area located in the heart of downtown Brooklyn, just one subway stop away from Manhattan. The CW Post Campus is located in Brookville, NY, approximately 30 miles east of Brooklyn on Long Island and serves approximately 7400 students.
