

Advertisement for Assistant Professor of Social Work

The Department of Social Work at Ashland University, a small private mid-western university, seeks candidates for a tenure-track, 9-month, Assistant Professor position beginning August, 2012. This position includes the designation of Field Director and is ideal for the person who is interested in both field education and the chance to teach a variety of courses and have opportunities for advancement. Candidates must possess an MSW from a CSWE-accredited program; have 2 years post-Master's social work experience, and a Ph.D. in Social Work or a closely related discipline. ABD considered. Candidates must have demonstrated teaching excellence at the college level. Of particular interest are candidates who have experience in teaching community practice and family violence. On-line teaching experience is also desirable. The work load is 21 credit hours with 3 credit hours per semester designated to directing the field program. As with all tenure-track appointments at Ashland University, faculty members are expected to conduct appropriate scholarship and research and participate in university service and student advising.

The Department of Social Work has been accredited by CSWE since 1988. Applications will be reviewed as received and until the position is filled.
