## Assistant Professor – BSW Program, Department of Social Work

Applications are currently invited for a tenure track Assistant Professor position to begin August 15, 2012. Primary expected teaching is in the BSW program. Other responsibilities include research/scholarship activity, service, academic advising, and participation in department and program governance.

Minimum qualifications include a Masters of Social Work degree and doctorate in Social Work or related field (preference will be give to candidates who currently hold a doctorate, however ABD will be considered with completion of doctorate by hire date), and beginning record of research/scholarship activity. Preference will be given to candidates with a minimum of two years post-MSW practice experience.
