FACULTY POSITION VACANCY

Applications are invited for a tenure-track social work faculty position in the Department of Social Work available Fall Semester, 2012. Candidates are expected to have a demonstrated commitment to excellence in social work education and practice, to be competent in contemporary approaches to social work education, able to apply information technology to social work education, and to establish an active program of scholarship and grant development.

Responsibilities: Teach social work courses in the curriculum areas of child welfare, macro-level social work practice, human behavior and the social environment, social welfare policy and programs, social work research, and field practicum. Faculty must also conduct research in specialty areas; provide academic and professional advising services to students; and be an active member of the academic and professional community.

Qualifications:

- Master of Social Work degree from a Council on Social Work Education accredited program
- Two (2) years of post MSW full-time social work practice experience
- Earned doctorate in social work or related discipline by time of appointment
- Teaching experience in undergraduate or graduate social work education
- Demonstrated use of information technology in social work education
- Record of scholarship and/or grant development
- History of community or professional service
