

***Faculty Position at Associate Professor Rank

Minimum requirements for candidates are 1) a doctoral degree in social work, social welfare, gerontology, or a closely related field, 2) a track record of publications in high-impact journals, 3) a track record of obtaining federal research grants, and 4) a track record of excellence in teaching.

Candidates should be able to 1) maintain an active research agenda leading to publication in peer-reviewed journals, 2) obtain federal grants or other external funds for state agencies or community-based research partnerships, 3) develop multidisciplinary research connections on and off the campus, and 4) teach across the curriculum with particular emphasis on gerontology, health disparities, health and mental health service delivery, research methods, and statistics.
