They are also required to have experience and knowledge of diverse communities and can demonstrate the ability to incorporate diversity into their research teaching, and engagement.

- Demonstrated track record in obtaining external funding to support the candidate's scholarship
- Skills in using a range of appropriate technology to enhance teaching
- Practice experience that involves working in interdisciplinary teams
