Under the general direction of the Unit Director or designated staff, the LPHA performs clinical activities such as independent assessments and service interventions as directed by the treatment plan and/or identified consumer

needs. This position interfaces with Treatment Teams both inpatient and outpatient and authorizes the medical necessity of services as indicated. This position may provide monitoring, clinical supervision, crisis intervention and training of staff. Requires knowledge of diagnostic criteria, specific clinical features and guidelines for formulating a diagnosis. Knowledge about cognitive behavioral therapy focusing on the reduction or elimination of severe and persistent mental illness. Must have Master's degree and licensed in the State of Texas (LCSW, LPC, or LMFT).

The LPHA partnered with the Houston Police Department Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) Officer comprises the Crisis Intervention Response Team (CIRT). The CIRT Team will interface with clients in need of mental health services as well as other Inter and Inter agency staff, both inpatient and outpatient. This position is responsible for providing the following services: Crisis Intervention, Mental Health Assessments, Case Management and Case Monitoring as part of the CIRT Team. The position will follow both MHMRA and Houston Police Department Operating Guidelines in regard to job roles, duties, safety and performance. Licensed credentials plus four years of clinical experience. Must have Master's degree and licensed in the State of Texas (LCSW, LMFT or LPC).
