Job Title: Faculty Positions

Job Description: Humboldt State University's College of Professional Studies invites applications for two full-time tenure-track or multi-year lecturer faculty positions in Social Work for the BASW and MSW programs.

Qualifications: For the tenure-track positions, a Doctorate in social work or related field from an accredited college or university or JD with practice experience in Federal Indian Law is required at time of appointment. Applicants with progress towards doctorate degree completion by appointment date will be considered.

For the multi-year lecturer positions, a record of teaching excellence at the college level is required.

The successful candidate must demonstrate the following:

- MSW with two years post-MSW experience or BASW with five years post-BASW experience;
- Experience working with Indigenous Peoples and/or other communities of color;
- Potential for or evidence of teaching effectiveness, scholarship and/or creative activities, and service to the community and the profession;
- Willingness to teach classes on campus and online, using synchronous and asynchronous methods;
- Record of and/or interest in teaching a broad range of courses using a variety of methodologies; and
- Commitment and/or experience promoting and fostering a learning environment that is supportive of individuals from diverse backgrounds.

Desirable qualifications may include one or more of the following:

- Experience working in rural communities;
- Teaching experience at the graduate and/or undergraduate level;
- Online teaching experience;
- Familiarity with critical social work; and
- Practice, research, or teaching in contexts that serve Indigenous Peoples.

At the time of appointment, the successful candidate, if not a U.S. citizen, must have authorization from the Bureau of Citizenship
