Job Title: Assistant/Associate Professor

Job Description: The University of Texas at El Paso, College of Health Sciences invites nominations and applications for the position of Assistant or Associate Professor of Social Work from talented individuals who will demonstrate excellence in research, teaching, and service. This position is a tenure-track/tenure eligible nine-month academic year appointment with the possibility of summer teaching. The appointment at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor will be commensurate with experience and qualifications. The successful candidate will serve as the Coordinator of the MSW Program with responsibility for leading an established program. The Coordinator will oversee the admission process, prepare the course schedule, chair the MSW Program Committee, work closely with the Field Education Coordinator to ensure appropriate and high quality MSW student placements, and ensure CSWE accreditation standards compliance. The MSW Program Coordinator reports to the Department Chair. Anticipated appointment date is Fall 2013.

Qualifications: (1) Earned doctoral degree in social work or a closely related field; (2) at least 3 years of community or university administrative experience; (3) an established track record of academic scholarship, such as research publications and conference presentations; (4) demonstrated potential for success in external fund development; (5) at least 3 years of teaching and mentoring in an accredited social work program; (6) history of or potential to conduct a program of teaching and research on border health and welfare issues in a bi-national, bi-cultural environment; (7) experience with CSWE accreditation processes; (8) MSW degree and a minimum of two years post-master's practice experience in social work; (9) licensure in Texas as an LMSW or LCSW or license-eligible in Texas; (10) participation in leadership roles in professional organizations; and (11) the ability to work effectively with faculty, staff, students, and community stakeholders from diverse ethnic, cultural, and socioeconomic backgrounds. Bilingual (English/Spanish) writing and speaking skills and experience with curriculum development and course scheduling are preferred.
