POSITION DESCRIPTION: The Department of Social Work in the Helen Bader School of Social Welfare seeks two tenured or tenure-track faculty.

DEPARTMENT DESCRIPTION: Recognized for translational and applied research, our faculty members collaborate with numerous agencies and organizations, especially in the Milwaukee area, to improve community services while informing social and intervention science. Substantive areas in which faculty are active include gerontology; child & family welfare; and mental, physical & behavioral health. The Department confers BSW, MSW, and Ph.D. degrees. The MSW program emphasizes both direct and macro practice methods, and offers interdisciplinary certificates in applied gerontology, public health, trauma-informed care, and non-profit management.

Qualifications: The qualified applicant will hold a PhD in social work or a related field. ABD will be considered if completion of the degree is imminent. Candidates must demonstrate competence in addressing diversity issues. Applicants should demonstrate potential for scholarly productivity and the ability to teach in one or more of the department's concentration areas as well as at the bachelors, masters, and doctoral levels.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS: An MSW degree is strongly preferred. Candidates with expertise in micro or macro practice are especially encouraged to apply. Applicants at the tenured level will demonstrate ability to secure extramural funding and to collaborate across disciplines and with community partners.
