Job Description: The faculty of the Department of Social Work at the University of Whitewater is seeking a colleague. Probationary tenure track faculty position in the Department of Social Work at the rank of Assistant Professor or Associate Professor beginning August 2013.

Qualifications: An MSW from a CSWE-accredited program with two years full-time post-MSW employment in social work, and a doctorate in social work (or related field) from a nationally accredited institution of higher education are required for initial appointment as an assistant professor. ABD will be considered, but doctorate must be completed by August 2013. Teaching experience and proficiency of educational technology are required. A commitment to undergraduate education is also expected.

Preference: will be given to candidates who demonstrate the ability to work effectively with those from diverse backgrounds and demonstrated cultural competence. Other considerations include experience and expertise in domestic violence, experience with educational technology and knowledge of the Council on Social Work Education accreditation standards.
