Our support groups assist individuals in recovery of Depression and Bipolar Disorders. Our general population groups are also open to family and friends for support. The Professional Facilitator is an LCSW or LPC who facilitates support groups. The Professional Support Group Facilitator plays an integral role in the recovery of those suffering with a mood disorder as they help to facilitate support, hope, empowerment, education, compassion, and understanding among group members. Each group is 90 minutes in duration and held on a weekly basis. Compensation is \$75 per support group facilitated. This position will be working with incarcerated individuals at the Jester Prison in Richmond Texas. It is a male only facility.
