Job Description	<p>The purpose of the Harris County Jail Diversion Pilot Project is the implementation of a program for persons with severe mental illness who have a history of multiple jail incarcerations for non-violent crimes. The primary goal of this pilot project is the reduction of criminogenic behaviors (and subsequent incarcerations) by provision of a highly coordinated intensive system of case management, health, mental health, chemical dependency, residential, rehabilitation and peer services.</p> <p>The Director of the Jail Diversion Pilot Project coordinates and facilitates the implementation, monitoring, evaluation, reporting and all associated local, state, and federal processes for all of the components of the Harris County Jail Diversion Pilot under SB 1185 (with an annual budget of \$10m).</p>
Qualifications	<p>Master's Degree from an accredited university in Healthcare Administration, Business Administration, Behavioral Sciences or a related field is required.</p> <p>EXPERIENCE: A minimum of six (6) years in healthcare project management including the implementation of new programs and/or expansion of existing services is required. Experience with administration and management of state/ federal grants including writing grants and federal reports and experience writing reports for proposals and managing contracts is required. Behavioral health experience is preferred.</p> <p>JOB SKILLS: The successful candidate must have working knowledge of various state/federal regulations and reporting requirements of a variety of grants. The ability to manage and/or operate a federal grant program, funding multiple projects including sub-recipient contracts and reporting responsibilities and, the ability to conduct detailed independent analysis or programmatic and related financial data is required. Must have a high level of interpersonal, oral and written communication skills and the ability to develop and maintain effective working relationships with government officials, private foundations, staff and other agencies.</p>
