Appointment at Associate or Full Professor rank begins August 2014. The Worden School offers BSW and MSW degree programs, both accredited by the Council on Social Work Education. The School offers traditional face-to-face and online social work program options.</p> <p>Founded in 1895 by the Congregation of Divine Providence, Our Lady of the Lake University is a co-educational institution for approximately 2,600 students, located near beautiful downtown San Antonio, TX. OLLU is a Hispanic-Serving Institution (HSI) with off-site locations in Houston and the Rio Grande Valley. The mission of OLLU is to ensure quality, innovative undergraduate and graduate learning experiences; foster spiritual, personal, and professional growth; and preparing students for success and continued service.</p> <p>The Worden School of Social Service (WSSS) is recognized nationally as the first School of Social Work in Texas. Student enrollment is over 500; there are over 300 students in the online MSW program. The School has eight full-time faculty positions and two administrative staff. Several of these positions have been recently added to help support the exponential growth in enrollment.</p> <p>OLLU is searching for a dynamic leader who will embrace the vision of the WSSS whose curriculum is focused on preparing students to work and serve communities and families that are predominantly Hispanic. The new Director will be committed to the vision and mission of OLLU and bring a passion for the continuing the growth of the Worden School.</p>
Qualifications	A doctorate in social work or a related field is required with at least two years post-MSW practice experience. The selected candidate must demonstrate a record of highly successful teaching, preferably including online teaching, scholarship, and university service. Candidates must have excellent interpersonal skills. Expertise in cross-cultural social work practice with emphasis on Hispanic families and children preferred. Program accreditation knowledge desired. Preference will be given to candidates with prior experience as a department chair or program coordinator.
