Job Description	<p>The Worden School of Social Service invites applications for a full-time eleven-month non-tenure track Assistant Professor Faculty position. Appointment begins January or August 2014. The position involves teaching on-campus or online, and administrative duties that support field education. Administrative duties including screening and arranging internship placements of online MSW students, implementing field education policies and procedures, and engaging in program assessment of student learning competencies. Expertise in cross-cultural social work practice with emphasis on Hispanic families and children desired. Additional responsibilities include serving as liaison with students and field educators, advising students, service to the university, engaging in research and scholarship, and service activities that support the institution's mission. Salary is competitive and commensurate with qualifications and experience.</p> <p>The Worden School offers BSW and MSW degree programs, both accredited by the Council on Social Work Education. The School offers traditional face-to-face and online social work program options. The School is recognized nationally as the first School of Social Work in Texas. Student enrollment is over 500; there are over 300 students in the online MSW program. The School currently has eight full-time faculty positions and two administrative staff.</p> <p>OLLU was founded in 1895, by the Congregation of Divine Providence and is classified as a Hispanic-Serving Institution (HSI) with locations in Houston and the Rio Grande Valley. The mission of OLLU is to ensure quality, innovative undergraduate and graduate learning experiences; foster spiritual, personal, and professional growth; and preparing students for success and continued service.</p>
