Associate Dean for Research

The College of Social Work at the University of South Carolina invites nominations and applications for an Associate Dean for Research. The position will be a full-time, tenured nine month academic appointment at a professor level with administrative responsibilities.

DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES: The primary goal of this position is to facilitate excellence in and expansion of the College's research capacity and scholarly productivity. The Associate Dean will be responsible for providing faculty, staff, and students with energetic leadership and expert mentorship in all aspects of research. The Associate Dean will also work closely with the Dean in the continued and active development of the College's research infrastructure, relationships with external funding agencies, intra- and inter-University collaborations, and community-engaged research efforts. The Associate Dean for Research will play a significant leadership role in the College, continue an active research agenda, teach courses or seminar, and contribute to the innovative research environment of the broader University.

QUALIFICATIONS: The successful candidate will have a doctoral degree in social work or a related field; a sustained record of scholarly activity and success in acquisition of externally-funded research grants and contracts from government and foundation sources; demonstrated ability to organize and manage research teams on large, interdisciplinary projects; extensive record of scholarly productivity through peer-reviewed publications, and excellent administrative and interpersonal skills to work in close cooperation with College and University leaders, faculty, students, and staff.

The University of South Carolina is among only 63 public universities listed by the Carnegie Foundation in the highest tier of research institutions in the United States. Founded in 1801, USC spans an eight-campus, fully-accredited public university system. The University of South Carolina is responsive to the needs of dual career couples.
