

# StAmbrose University

The School of Social Work at St. Ambrose University invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant or Associate Professor in Social Work, beginning July 1, 2012. Responsibilities include student advising, university committee service, scholarship, and ability to teach across the Social Work curriculum. This MSW-only program has a single concentration in Empowerment Social Work Practice. The position requires an MSW from a CSWE-accredited program and an earned doctorate in social work or related field. Applications from ABD's will be considered. A minimum of two years post-MSW experience is required and evidence of effective teaching is essential. Salary will be commensurate with rank and experience. Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled. Applicants who have submitted information by mid-October will have an opportunity for an initial interview at the 2011 CSWE APM in Atlanta. Women and persons of diverse cultural and ethnic background are especially encouraged to apply. Priority will be given to applicants showing a strong commitment to teaching and scholarly engagement. St. Ambrose is a Catholic, Diocesan University located in Davenport, Iowa, which is a mid-sized urban area on the Mississippi River, enrolling over 3700 students.
