



**Warren Wilson College  
Social Work Faculty Position**

The Department of Social Work at Warren Wilson College invites applications for an entry-level faculty position in our undergraduate social work program. This is a full-time, continuing position in our extended contract system, with responsibilities in teaching and expectations of program or field leadership development in the department beginning July 1, 2012.

The successful candidate will have a minimum of two years post-MSW professional practice experience and experience in teaching social work education. The position requires a PhD in social work or related field (in hand by August 1, 2012). Desirable candidates will demonstrate the following attributes: excellent interpersonal, oral and written communication skills, engaged scholarship, strong organization/program development, management, training, and evaluation skills, competence in working with diverse groups, such as students, faculty, institutional administration, and community leaders, and evidence of teaching excellence across the baccalaureate generalist social work curriculum, especially integration of service-learning.

This position is part of a two-person department within the Social Sciences Division. A faculty member in this position will teach courses in the generalist curriculum from introductory level to capstone. We welcome candidates with all areas of professional specialization, and are particularly interested in those with the proven ability to teach micro, mezzo, and macro practice, human behavior and the social environment, and advocacy/policy. The successful candidate will be expected to teach and develop departmental courses in their area(s) of professional expertise, and serve the college curriculum more broadly through the potential teaching of first-year seminar and study abroad courses. This faculty member will collaborate in departmental activities including academic advising, maintaining compliance with CSWE accreditation standards, development and implementation of departmental and field policies and procedures, and other departmental and field tasks. A faculty member in this position will actively engage in the life of the college in such ways as campus-wide committees and shared governance.

The Social Work Program at Warren Wilson College has been continually accredited by CSWE since 1978. The program has three distinct, integrated areas of focus: multi-generational practice, environmental sustainability, and international/global perspective.
